Exodus 19:5	Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine.
Genesis 1:26	Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.'
Genesis 35:3	Then let us arise and go up to Bethel; and I will make an altar there to God, who answered me in the day of my distress and has been with me in the way which I have gone.'
Genesis 39:12	that she caught him by his garment, saying, 'Lie with me.' But he left his garment in her hand, and fled and ran outside.
Genesis 3:15	And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel.'
Genesis 45:4	And Joseph said to his brothers, 'Please come near to me.' So they came near. Then he said: 'I am Joseph your brother, whom you sold into Egypt.'
Genesis 45:5	But now, do not therefore be grieved or angry with yourselves because you sold me here; for God sent me before you to preserve life.
Genesis 4:7	If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire is for you, but you should rule over it.'
Genesis 6:11	The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.
Genesis 6:5	Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
Hosea 4:6	My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children.
Jeremiah 29:11	For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.
Jeremiah 29:13-14	And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart. Acts 3:19	Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord,
Acts 4:12	Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.'
Acts 8:37	Then Philip said, 'If you believe with all your heart, you may.' And he answered and said, 'I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.'
Acts 8:38	So he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and he baptized him.
Galatians 3:27	For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.
Hebrews 5:9	And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him,
Hebrews 9:28	so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.
Mark 16:16	He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.
Philippians 2:11	and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
Romans 10:17	So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
Romans 1:16	For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.
Romans 1:17	For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, 'The just shall live by faith.'
Romans 3:23	for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
Romans 6:23	For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
Romans 6:3	Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death?
Romans 6:4	Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Hebrews 13:4	Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge.
Hebrews 3:1	Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus,

1 Corinthians 13:7	bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.
1 Corinthians 13:8	Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away.
1 Corinthians 13:9	For we know in part and we prophesy in part.
1 John 1:7	But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.
1 John 2:16	For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father but is of the world.
1 John 2:6	He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.
